Driving Directions: Traveling From: I-64 East or I-64 West (Norfolk, Chesapeake, Virginia Beach area) Continue on I-64 and follow signs to exit on Route 264 East Virginia Beach, Exit 284 A. Follow 264 East toward Virginia Beach Oceanfront to Exit 22 (Birdneck Rd). Bear right off exit ramp, merging onto Birdneck Road. Turn left onto 19th Street (see McDonald's on your left at intersection as a landmark.) Travel approximately 1-½ to 2 blocks and hotel will be on your left. Turn left onto Pavilion Drive to access main entrance and parking to the Double Tree by Hilton Virginia Beach.

Military Aviation Museum

Take a journey back in time to when aircraft were spectacular and heroes never let us down. The Military Aviation Museum displays and owns the largest flying collection of WWI and WWII Military Aircraft in the USA. The museum provides a permanent home for more than 63 WWII and earlier vintage flying aircraft. The museum's ongoing mission is to preserve, restore, and fly these historic aircraft and provide an experience to learn what our parents, grandparents and great grandparents might have endured on the lonely airfield and factories, and in the skies so very far from home. Your visit will include a guided tour of the Museum's WWI, WWII and Korean era warplanes housed in five large hangars and display areas. You will visit the Fighter Factory where the repair, upkeep, and restoration of the magnificent warbirds are performed. Walk through history as the Museum's docents tell the stories of these pilots and warbirds." 1341 Princess Anne Rd, VA Beach, VA 23457 Website: www.militaryaviationmuseum.org Tour takes 2 to 2-½ hours.

Car Pool Only - Meet in main lobby ground level at 1:15 p.m. Travel approximately 13.5 miles for 27 minutes.

Virginia Aquarium and Marine Science Center

The Virginia Aquarium & Marine Science Center is Virginia's largest aquarium, displays the state's various aquatic and marine environments throughout time, and features more than 800,000 gallons of aquarium and live animal exhibits. With more than 300 hands-on exhibits, visitors experience the wonders of harbor seals, river otters, sea turtles, sharks, seahorses, an aviary and more. Must sees" include the Harbor Seal Pool, an IMAX® 3D Theatre and a one-third mile-long nature trail that connects to an outdoor aviary offering an up-close glimpse of the marsh birds. Enjoy scenery on the 10-minute walk on the Owls Creek Path that meanders through salt marsh and woodland preserve between the Aquarium's main building and Marsh Pavilion (additional building with exhibits). Climb the 30-foot observation tower to get a view of Owls Creek from tree-top level. On the other hand, you may wish to drive to the Marsh Pavilion if the weather is uncomfortable. If interested in I-MAX movie, call the Aquarium to check on the I-MAX feature playing on Saturday, February 4, 2017 prior to adding the fee to your registration form. Whale & Wildlife Trips are available from December through March and leave from the Virginia Aquarium. Old Coast Guard Station - Virginia Beach

"Housed in a 1903 former U.S. Life Saving Station, this oceanfront museum features rescue equipment used by turn-of-the-century surf men to save shipwrecked crews from a watery grave. Learn about shipwrecks that occurred off the Virginia Beach coast and the history of lifesaving service from World War II to the present." Cape Henry Lighthouses

"These beacons of safe harbors and welcoming shores have long spoken of the romance between sea and land. Now you can learn of the history of the original octagonal brick Cape Henry Lighthouse, authorized by George Washington and completed in 1792, along with its slightly more modern cast iron sibling. Climb to the top of the earliest lighthouse and enjoy a spectacular view. The Cape Henry Lighthouse is located on the Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek-Fort Story. Public entrance is located at 89th St. and Atlantic Ave. Access to military bases may be restricted for public tours, and a valid picture ID and vehicle search is required at main gate entrance." First Landing State Park

"First Landing State Park is the site of the first landing of Jamestown colonists in 1607. The park is a National Historic Landmark and the most visited state park in Virginia. Located just north of the Resort Area of Virginia Beach, First Landing has 20 miles of trails and 1.5 miles of oceanfront beach.
