4-H Enrollment

240,812 members

- 50.3% females
- 49.6% males
- 36% minority enrollment



4-H Adult Volunteers

15,519 volunteers



Where 4-H Members Live:

- 3% Farms
- 31% Towns and Rural Areas of 10,000 or less population
- 23% Towns and Cities of 10,000-50,000 population
- 42% Suburbs and Cities of 50,000 or more population



Age of 4-H Members: (Does not add up to 100% due to special and not in school members)

- 43% Cloverbud (5-8 years of age)
- 36% Juniors (9-11 years of age)
- 11% Intermediates (12-13 years of age)
- 10% Seniors (14-19 years of age)
