Poultry Service Learning Timeline

- Fall
 - Secure funding for projects. Coordinate processing.
- Winter
 - Participants choose broiler or layer projects
 - Layer chicks raised for first 12 weeks at a local farm
 - Training for participants in the winter and distribution of supplies
- Spring
 - Pullet and chick distribution
 - Youth donate eggs and submit monthly reports
- Summer
 - Youth donate eggs and submit monthly reports
 - Processing at a local farm
- Fall
 - Youth complete and turn in project books
 - Grant reports due
 - Judging of project books and recognition at annual Achievement Banquet

Livestock Service Learning

- Animals that are floored used to be sold at the Livestock Exchange
- Now thanks to grant funding, we process and donate all the animals that have been floored
- In 2021, that was 9 hog, 3 steers, 10 lambs, and 3 goats.
