Tentative Showmanship Agenda:

The Foundation

At its core, showmanship consists of six basic maneuvers that are combined in various orders and degrees of difficulty to form a pattern. These basics are leading at a walk, leading at a jog/trot, stopping, backing, setting up for inspection, and pivoting. They form the foundation of showmanship training. Each segment will have a Goal, Starting Point, and Training Steps. At the end of our clinic, we will perform a beginner appropriate pattern.

Tentative Riding Agenda:

Open to all disciplines. We will be covering what makes a balanced rider with a controlled seat and leg. Along with keeping safety first at the horse show. Which includes how to properly maneuver in show arena, practice arena traffic and the dos and don'ts of show etiquette. The last 30 minutes of the riding lesson both groups will ride together in one arena to learn about arena traffic and how to safely navigate a busy arena.
