51. **TRAIL** - Sign-off Class for 4-H State Show participation. This class only to be held in covered arena, 4492 Catterton Rd from noon till 4 pm. A class pattern and rules will be e-mailed to you upon receipt of your entry.

General Rules:

- * Classes follow rules and specifications set by the USEF and VHSA.
- * Judge's decision is final.
- * Proof of negative Coggins on all ponies and horses (current within one year) is required at registration. This report is also required for horses or ponies who travel to the show but do not enter any classes.
- * Membership in VHSA is not required to compete in this show. Membership forms are available at the secretary's booth, but must be completed and turned in by the end of the show in order for points to count.
- * All entry forms must be completed and signed by the participant or by a parent, guardian, or trainer for juniors.
- * All riders when mounted must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet.
- * Proper tack and attire required. In extreme heat, coats may be excused at the judge's discretion.
- * Junior riders are those 17 and under on December 1, 2018.
- * Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in each division.
- * Points will accrue as follows: 1st – 10, 2nd – 6, 3rd – 4, 4th – 2, 5th – 1, 6th – .5, Champ. – 10, Res. – 6.
- * No dogs allowed.
- * No alcohol is allowed on the show grounds.
- * Fee for returned checks is \$35.
- * Unjudged rounds are permitted for the regular class fee for each round.
- * Divisions may be combined, split, or canceled at the discretion of the show management.
- * Any questions or disputes that are not covered in the above Rules and Specifications or in any other section of this prize list, shall be subject to the decision of the show management.
- * The Horse Show management, volunteers and property owners are not responsible for any accident or injury to spectators, riders, handlers, their property, animals or possessions. Entering the show grounds constitutes acceptance of this policy.
