SHOW RULES

1. **15 mph speed limit strictly enforced**
2. Negative coggins within 12 mo. MUST be shown at entry
3. Hard hats must be worn while mounted, proper attire required
4. No Martingales in under saddle classes
5. Rider's age as of December 1st
6. **NO dogs strictly enforced**
7. No one will be allowed in the ring until they have entered and Received a number
8. The Management reserves the right to combine, cancel, or Divide classes as needed
9. Points in all classes shall be scored as follows: 1st/10pt. 2nd/6pt., 3rd /4pt., 4th/2pt, 5th/1pt, 6th/.5pt. Champion- 10pt. Res.- 6pt.
10. Judge's decision is final
11. Courses posted at the in gate
12. G.L.C. Horse Haven Farm will not be held responsible for any loss or accident which may occur at any spectator, horse rider or personal property

CLASS RULES

1. Walk Trot- Open to all amateur riders, horses and ponies that are not ready to show at the canter. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter to any canter or jumping class.
2. Short Stirrup Hunter- Open to children 12 and under. Trotting permitted. Four fences at 18".
3. Pleasure Pony - ponies 14.2 and under, Jr. riders
4. Beginner Hunter - Open to horse/rider combination , who have never shown over fences exceeding 2' in height. Trotting over fences will not be penalized . Four fences at 18"
5. Special Hunter -Open to horses or ponies ridden by any age rider. Fences choice 2' or 2' 6".
6. Pony/Green Pony Hunter - Open to all ponies 14.2 and under, fences 2'3 sm/md ponies, 2'6" large ponies, Jr. Riders. Green must be in 1st yr of showing.
7. VHSA Equitation 0/f - Fences 2'6"
8. VHSA Equitation on Flat - Riders to work at walk, trot, canter.
9. Low Hunter - Open to horse or ponies, fences 2'
10. Pleasure Horse - Open to all horses
11. Schooling Hunter - Open to horses or ponies ridden by any age rider. Fences 2', 2'6" or 3

RICHMOND - take 360 west to 307 to 460 west, take 2nd Farmville exit (Keysville). Take left off of exit ramp, go to first light and take right onto Commerce Rd. go 1 1/2 mi. take left onto German Town Rd. go to stop sign, take left onto Back Hampden Sydney Rd. go 1 mi. farm is on left.

LYNCHBURG - take 460 east to 2nd Farmville exit (Keysville), take right off exit ramp go to first light turn right onto Commerce Rd go 1 1/2 mi. take left onto German Town Rd. go to stop sign, take left onto Back Hampden Sydney Rd. go 1 mi. farm is on left.

KEYSVILLE - take 15 north to first light take left onto 133, then stay to right onto 692, go 1 mi. turn right onto Five Forks Rd., go 1/4 mi. turn right onto Back Hampden Sydney Rd. go 1 1/2 mi. farm is on right.

CUMBERLAND - take 45 south to Farmville go to 4th light, turn right onto High St. go straight thru next light go 3 1/2 miles from last light farm is on left. igh St. will turn into Back Hampden Sydney Rd.

BUCKINGHAM - take 15 south to 460 east to 1st Farmville exit (Keysville) take right off exit ramp, go to first light turn right onto Commerce Rd., go 1 1/2 mi. take left onto German Town Rd., go to stop sign take left onto Back Hampden Sydney Rd., go 1 mi. farm is on left
