PROCEDURES FOR CHECK-IN ON SHOW DAY:

1. Pre-Registered exhibitor will receive a packet at the secretary's stand containing their show number(s) and a show schedule. An entry form for each rider/horse combination executed by exhibitor must be completed and received. If under 18 years of age you must have parent/guardian sign your entry form.
2. Exhibitors not pre-registered will need to complete an entry form for each rider/horse combination executed by exhibitor. If under 18 years of age you must have parent/guardian sign your entry form.
3. A copy of your horses current negative Coggins must be provided and kept by show official. No one is allowed on the premises or will be allowed to show without a current negative Coggins.
4. A waiver must be signed by anyone who will be mounted. These waivers will be provided at the show to be executed.
5. A check payable to: Treasurer of VA Tech.
6. Pre-Registration is \$8.00 per class until two days prior to show. Registration after pre-registration deadline will be \$10.00 per class. See registration form for classes/divisions offered to complete your registration.
7. If you are qualifying for the State horse show, there is a \$5.00 flat fee charged in addition to the show class fees. This fee will be paid to the District Council.
8. Upon completion of steps 1-7 above, your number will be issued. Please wear your number at all times when mounted or when showing your horse in the in-hand classes, including Horsemanship Skills I.
9. If your horse does not have an official green measurement card, you can get your horse measured by the Official Measurer in the designated area.
10. All exhibitors needing Horsemanship Skills I, please report at 9:00 a.m. in the designated ring with your horse/pony and grooming equipment. Your evaluator will further instruct and test you at this time.
11. Parking – Parking will be directed upon arrival. Cars may be asked to park in a separate area from trailers. Please pick up any manure your horse leaves by your trailer. Please be courteous to parking officials. They are here to help you get in and out as easily and safely as possible.

SHOW RULES:

1. The Majestic Hooves 4-H Qualifying horse show will be operating in accordance with the rules and regulations of the State 4-H Horse Show.
2. All riders attempting to qualify must be bona fide 4-H horse project members. All horses that an exhibitor will show must be registered as their project animals and a part of their Horse Project Record to qualify.
3. Qualifying is the act of taking the project animal into the ring under the eye of the judge for at least one class during the horse show and completing the class successfully in the opinion of the judge.
4. Exhibitors who are Juniors ("Jr.") must turn at least 9 years of age but not older than 13 years old as of September 30, 2020. Exhibitors who are Seniors ("Sr.") are 14 years of age through 18 years of age as of September 30, 2020 but who have not achieved their 19th birthday by January 1st of the current 4-H year.
5. This is an open show. Adults and Non 4-H Members may compete. All non 4-H members can compete in the age appropriate classes labeled "Junior," "Teen," or "Open." No riders under the age of 9.
6. Members are allowed to qualify more than one project horse at this show. However, we are not able to hold up a class to wait on you.
7. A horse can be qualified by more than one 4-H member. However, the animal must be registered as the project animal of all youth showing it, and each youth must be keeping records on the animal. The horse may not be shown in the same division or class by more than one exhibitor.
8. Exhibitor and animal combination may cross enter other divisions, disciplines and classes, however, please be mindful of ring times and the arenas will not be held.

9. Horses and ponies must be healthy and sound and must be suitable to the rider. Suitability will be noted in all classes and safety kept in mind during all classes.
10. Member exhibitors out of District are welcome to qualify at this show. Please check with your District first. If you are unable to qualify at this show, you can still participate in the open show and take advantage of our Horsemanship Skills I & II and Official Measuring opportunity.
11. Sportsmanship is the 4-H way. Any discourtesy to a judge or show official by any exhibitor, parent, friend, relative or leader may cause an exhibitor to forfeit all ribbons and disqualify the exhibitor from showing in future 4-H horse shows. Appeals are to be made to the Show Manager by the exhibitor only. Judge's cards will not be posted. Judges may be approached only by way of the Show Manager.
12. The judge's decision will be final and may not be protested.
13. The show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide class(es) as necessary.
14. Novice Rider means any horse or exhibitor in their 1st or 2nd year of competition.
15. English Pleasure saddle seat tack and attire.
16. Horsemanship Skills I & II are offered throughout the day. Successful completion of Levels One and Two are required for participation at the State Show. (Exception – those horse/rider combinations who have previously shown at a State Show.) Level one must be passed in its entirety. If member fails any part of Level I they must retest on all Level One skill. With Level Two, any individual skills missed may be retested without redoing the whole level. If a member has to return to one of the skills testing, there is not an additional charge at this show.
17. Open Schooling will be permitted at the designated times prior to the class. Only exhibitors may ride or school their animals during this time. No lunging or hand walking in the ring during schooling breaks.
18. Six ribbons will be awarded for each class and Championship and Reserve ribbons will be awarded for each division.
19. Only authorized personnel will be allowed in the rings.
20. No dogs or stallions permitted on show grounds.
21. It is the responsibility of the 4-H member to obtain the rules and entry forms and to submit their completed entry on time. Incomplete or inaccurate forms may result in the member not being allowed to qualify. Animals without a current coggins will not be allowed on the show grounds.
22. Neither the Show, Show Committee, Central District Horse Council, nor the Chesterfield Fair Grounds, its owners, employees, and volunteers will be held responsible for any accident to the person or property of any exhibitor, spectator or any other persons during this event.
23. Parents and exhibitors signing entry forms will be responsible for verification of eligibility. All members and parents are encouraged to read the rules in detail prior to entering the show. Signatures by the exhibitor and parent indicate that they have read the rules and that they understand any penalty of disqualification or elimination.

RULES FOR EXHIBITORS:

1. All exhibitors should be neat and appropriately dressed. Standard riding and work attire is required in the exercise areas at all times. Standard riding equipment is required and bareback riding is prohibited.
2. Chaps and spurs are optional in Western Equitation and the Western Divisions.
3. All 4-H members and anyone under the age of 18 are **REQUIRED** to wear and use ASTM SEI APPROVED headgear and other safety items at all 4-H event. Safety helmets must be worn with CHIN STRAP FASTENED. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time will be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear will be worn without penalty or discrimination in all divisions and classes.

4. It is the responsibility to be on time for all classes. A two minute gate call will be issued before the start of each class. There will be an order of go for all Showmanship, Western and speed classes. Any competitor adding a class will be put at the end of the order. Exhibitors showing more than one animal in more than one division must be aware of this and make class choices accordingly.
5. Add on classes must be made at least 3 classes prior to class. Classes may be dropped without penalty, but there will be no refunds.
6. An entry can be scratched and receive a refund by contacting the Show Manager, **on or before April 17, 2020 before 9:00 p.m.** After this date, refunds will be given only on the receipt of a veterinary certificate.
