- * Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in each division.
- * Points will accrue as follows: $1^{st} 10$, $2^{nd} 6$, $3^{rd} 4$, $4^{th} 2$, $5^{th} 1$, $6^{th} .5$, Champ.
