General Rules:

- * This show is **open to enrolled 4-H members** only and will follow all 4-H rules.
- * Successful completion of at least one class constitutes qualification for the State Show.
- * Judge's decision is final.
- * Proof of negative Coggins on all ponies and horses (current within one year) is required at registration. This report is also required for horses or ponies who travel to the show but do not enter any classes.
- * It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for all classes. A two-minute gate call will be issued before the start of each class.
- * All class additions or scratches must be made four classes prior to the class.
- * All riders when mounted must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet.
- * No dogs or stallions allowed on the show grounds.
- * Proper tack and attire required. In extreme heat, coats may be excused at the judge's discretion.
- * It is the responsibility of any competitor that is trail qualifying to get the paperwork signed from show management.
- * Juniors are 13 years old or under as of September 30, 2021. Seniors are 14 or older as of September 30, 2021.
- * Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in each division.
- * No alcohol is allowed on the show grounds.
- * Fee for returned checks is \$35.
- * Divisions may be combined, split, or canceled at the discretion of the show management.
- * Any questions or disputes that are not covered in the above Rules and Specifications or in any other section of this prize list, shall be subject to the decision of the show management.
- * This show will follow all 4-H state show rules.
- * The Horse Show management, volunteers and property owners are not responsible for any accident or injury to spectators, riders, handlers, their property, animals or possessions. Entering the show grounds constitutes acceptance of this policy.

Virginia 4-H Covid Rules:

4-H youth are known for their citizenship, respect, and efforts to always do what is right. Horse shows are an opportunity for these youth to wear masks, physical distance, and set a good example, regardless of personal beliefs. Riders/horse handlers will not be discounted in the ring for wearing a face covering, such as a gaiter pulled down on their neck, while handling or showing a horse.

To attend our show, you must agree to the following for the safety and well-being of others in attendance at this show.

- Follow all COVID-19 recommendations set forth by VCE
- Wear face coverings unless directly handling an equine.
- Physical distance 6 ft apart from others, with the exception of immediate family members. Extra care must be considered in the vicinity of horse handlers that are not wearing face coverings.
- Social media posts must clearly exhibit appropriate physical distancing and those pictured must be wearing masks unless handling a horse. Adhere to the markers placed for physical distancing in the line-up at the arena gate and at the show secretary's check-in, and other areas as marked
- Leaving the grounds as soon as participation is complete.
- Do not invite extra spectators or guests. The show is limited to competitors, trainers, riders, grooms, owners, competition staff, and parents or other adults attending as a minor's guardian only.
- Exhibitors and their family members or pods (non-family groups traveling together) are not required to wear face coverings at their own personal vehicle/horse trailer (considered their home base). When leaving home base, all individuals must wear a face covering. If at any point, you or any family member participating, is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 while at the show or prior to the show, you will excuse yourself from the event, and notify show management. Symptoms include
 - experiencing fever (100.4°F or higher) or a sense of having a fever,
 - a new cough that cannot be attributed to another health condition,
 - new shortness of breath that cannot be attributed to another health condition,
 - new chills that cannot be attributed to another health condition,
 - a new sore throat that cannot be attributed to another health condition,
 - new muscle aches that cannot be attributed to another health condition or specific activity (such as physical exercise).
- If at any point you or any family member participating experiences symptoms of COVID-19 within 14 days after the show, you agree to notify show management immediately.
