Dates & Location

July 11-16, 2020 at Virginia Tech, Alphin Stuart Livestock Arena (500 Plantation Rd. Blacksburg, Va.)

Cost and Registration Deadline?

\$775, April 10, 2020

How many spots are there at the camp?

The camp is open to 16 participants

Who is eligible?

Any Virginia 4-H member who is age 14-18 as of 9/30/20

Non 4-H members will have to opportunity to register if the camp does not fill after April 10, 2020 for an additional \$100

Do I have to bring my own horse?

Yes! All campers must bring their own horse!

The camp is open to all disciplines of riding!

What must I do to register for camp?

To register for camp, applicants must fill out the **Virginia 4-H Hokie Horse Camp Application** and the **Health History form** and submit it with a \$450 non-refundable deposit by April 10, 2020 to secure their spot. The applications will be sorted by postmark date to secure spots in the camp. If multiple applications are received on the same day, they will be sorted by DOB, with the oldest being ranked first for spots.

After the 16 spots are filled, the remaining applicants will be placed on a waiting list that is first come, first serve by **EMAIL ONLY** and will be notified if they receive a spot at camp as soon as they become available.

If there are any remaining spots as of April 10, 2020, the camp will then open to non 4-H members who are residents of Virginia. If those spots do not fill by June 1, 2020, the camp will then be open to non-Virginia residents. Non 4-H members and non-Virginia residents will pay an additional \$100 to participate in the camp.
