Skills are to be driven with proper head position, bending and suppleness, calmness, lightness, rhythm, and coordination using all driving aids.		
4-2 Drivers will turn out in appropriate attire for a Breed rated or USEF sanctioned pleasure driving daytime show. Horses will be shown in safe and appropriate driving tack within breed or discipline specific rules. (Optional equipment overchecks, sidechecks, ect. 4-3 Perform American Driving Society Super Reinsmanship Test #1		
4-4 Complete an untimed driven obstacle class as defined below. Emphasis is on safety and accuracy. Class will simulate ADS Pleasure Driving Town and Country courses and may include the following elements: At least 30% of the obstacles must not be a pair of cones, but instead an obstacle that could be encountered while out driving through town or country; i.e., mailbox and cones, trash barrel and cone, flagpole and a cone, fence section and cone, bridge, poles set like guardrails, wood piles. Clearances L-shaped and U-Shaped obstacle - 12 ft (3.6 m) Cones on Course will have a 12" clearance for all drivers
