THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS UNLESS INJURY TO RIDER OR HORSE OCCURS PRIOR TO THIS SHOW AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY INFORCED! A \$30.00 fee will be added for any returned checks.

- i. Entry Fee per horse/exhibitor combinations \$20.00 for division or \$8.00 per class to VT- Fauquier County.
- ii. Bring with you to the show: CHECK FOR FEES, COPY OF CURRENT COGGINS, HEALTH HISTORY FORM, SIGNED EQUINE RELEASE, and WAIVER & INDEMNIFICATION FORM.
- iii. No Class changes day of show EXCEPT to Scratch.
- iv. The Judge's decision is always FINAL! SPORTSMANSHIP IS THE 4-H WAY. Any discourtesy to a judge or show official by any exhibitor, parent, or leader may cause an exhibitor to forfeit all ribbons and trophies and disqualify the exhibitor from showing in future 4-H horse shows. APPEALS ARE TO BE MADE TO THE STEWARD AND SHOW COMMITTEE BY THE EXHIBITOR ONLY. Judges may be approached only by the way of the STEWARD.
- v. Age Divisions will be as follows: (Members may show in only 1 division.) (Horses/Ponies may be shared, but may not be ridden in more than 2 Divisions.) Seniors - Age 14-18 (As of September 30, 2017) Juniors - Age 9-13 (As of September 30, 2017)
- vi. ASTM approved helmets are mandatory and must be worn at all times while mounted.
- vii. Schooling attire is expected and will be ENFORCED. No sleeveless shirts, unless covered with a JACKET.
- viii. For further rules and regulations, see county rules.
- ix. There will be a two-minute gate call for all classes Please be prompt. If you have a tack/rider change, let ring steward know ahead of time and you will be excused from the line-up to go out and change. Please make sure announcer or ring steward knows in advance of these changes.
- x. Any Class may be required to ride a pattern at the judge's discretion.
- xi. At the discretion of the show committee classes may be combined due to class size (to be announced).
