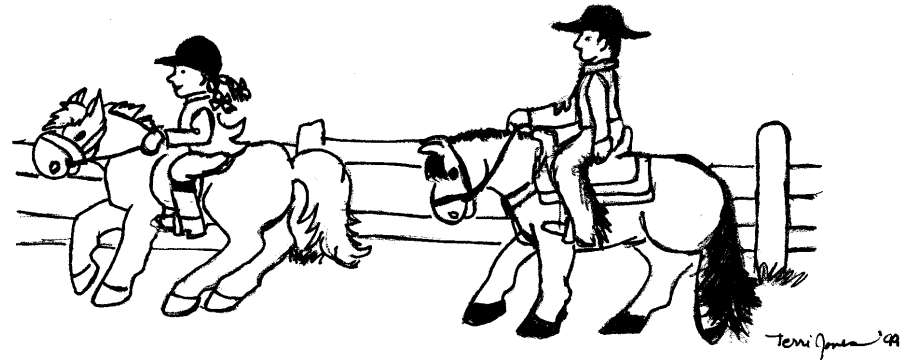

# Fauquier County 4-H Horse Show Rules April 28, 2018

This show is open to currently enrolled 4-Hers of Fauquier County, and surrounding counties.

**Pre-Entry must be received by 5:00 p.m., April 26, 2018. Mail or drop off to Kim Abel, 3510 Rock Run Road, Goldvein, VA 22720 or Fauquier Extension Office, 24 Pelhan Street, Warrenton, VA 20186.**

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS UNLESS INJURY TO RIDER OR HORSE OCCURS PRIOR TO THIS SHOW AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED! A \$30.00 fee will be added for any returned checks.

- i. Entry Fee per horse/exhibitor combinations is **\$25** per division and **\$5** per individual classes (Fauquier County), **\$30** per division **\$7** per individual classes (Out of County).
- ii. A copy of NEGATIVE COGGINS is required with your entry in order to obtain your entry number on show day.
- iii. The Judges decision is always FINAL! SPORTSMANSHIP IS THE 4-H WAY. **Any discourtesy to a judge or show official by any exhibitor, parent, or leader will cause an exhibitor to forfeit all ribbons and trophies and may disqualify the exhibitor from showing in future 4-H horse shows. APPEALS ARE TO BE MADE TO THE STEWARD AND SHOW COMMITTEE BY THE EXHIBITOR ONLY. Judges may be approached only by the way of the STEWARD.**
- iv. **Age Divisions will be as follows:**  
(Horses/Ponies may shared but may not be ridden in more than 3 Divisions.)  
**Seniors - Age 14-18 (As of 30 Sep 10)**  
**Juniors - Age 9-13 (As of 30 Sep 10)**  
**Green Rider - This is walk/trot only for beginner riders ONLY in their first or second year of showing at any show. 4-H Green Riders may not enter any other classes except Showmanship, Green Rider Trail, and Driving classes. Ties in the Green rider division will be broken by equitation placing.**
- v. **ASTM approved helmets are mandatory and must be worn at all times while mounted.**
- vi. Schooling or show attire is expected and will be ENFORCED. No sleeveless shirts (unless covered with a JACKET), Polo shirts, boots, belt, long pants, tie or neck decoration for Western classes are required. Choker collars or monogrammed turtleneck with hunt coats, belts, breeches/boots or jodhpurs/paddock boots for English classes may be worn. Speed class, long sleeve shirts are requested.
- vii. For further rules and regulations, see county rules.
- viii. There will be a two-minute gate call for all classes – Please be prompt. If you have a tack/rider change, let ring steward know ahead of time and you will be excused from the line-up to go out and change. Please make sure announcer or ring steward knows in advance of these changes.
- ix. **While line-up is waiting for pinning results, next class is to go ahead and enter the ring at a walk and stay on the rail and wait for announcer to tell you that judging has begun.**
- x. **Command Class may be required to hand-gallop and must show a difference in gaits when asked in a timely manner.**
- xi. **Equitation Classes may be required to ride a pattern, which will be posted.**
- xii. **At the discretion of the show committee classes may be combined or split due to class size (to be announced).**

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

**Showmanship** - to be judged on overall cleanliness and grooming of the horse, proper turn-out of horse and handler, and proper execution of pattern (conformation will not count). Horses/ponies must be shown using the quarter system.

**Go-As-You-Please** – Riders are to work on rail at walk and gait of choice (trot/jog or canter/lope). Green Rider Walk/Trot or Walk/Jog). You must choose and perform the same gait both directions of the ring.

**Pleasure Class** - Riders to perform at the walk, trot/jog, canter/lope BOTH directions of ring.

**Equitation/Reinsmanship Classes** - Riders may be asked to perform a pattern.

**Trail** - Riders to perform various trail obstacles that will be posted for each division.

**Command** - Riders to perform on the rail at various gates. Riders making errors will be called to the middle of the ring until the last horse is left.

**Pleasure Driving** - Open to ponies and horses pulling any suitable vehicle - at a walk, pleasure gait, and road gait. Judged on manners and performance. An adult may be present in the vehicle, but their assistance will be penalized.

**Speed** – Open to ponies or horses. May be rode in English or Western tack. Best time wins.
