Subject: 2019 SW District 4-H Horse Camp

The 2019 SW District 4-H Horse Camp will be held on April 12-13, 2019 at the SWVA 4-H Education Center in Abingdon, VA. The camp is conducted for youth (age 9-18 or 8 year olds who turn 9 during 4-H year-October 1, 2018-September 30, 2019) and their <u>one</u> equine friend (horse, pony, or mule). 4-Hers will participate in activities designed to teach horsemanship skills that may include riding, nutrition, equine health, and many other educational components. A trained staff of adult volunteers will be overseeing the participants in all activities.

- Arrival and check in at 4-H Center on April 12th, 4:30-6:00pm (Dinner on your own before arrival)
- Departure from camp on April 13th, 8:00pm
- Cost \$100. <u>Camp fee and registration due by March 30th</u>. Please make checks payable to
 <u>VCE -Smyth</u> and mail all components of the registration to 121 Bagley Circle, Suite 434 Marion VA
 24354.

Participants staying for the whole weekend will be housed in the Lodge at the 4-H Center and will need to bring their own:

- Sleeping Bags, Sheets, Blankets, etc.
- Towels and Washcloths
- Toiletries
- Boots and Jeans or other riding clothes (Shows Clothes are not necessary)
- Jackets (fleece, rain, outerwear for weather)
- Rain Gear
- Helmets are required!!

For the animal, a copy of the current Coggins is required. Up to date inoculations are strongly recommended for optimum animal health.

Participants need to bring the following for their animals:

- Feed, hay (enough for 2 nights) and feed/water buckets and hangers, snaps etc. for buckets
- Halter and lead, lunge line, ties, etc.
- Stall cleaning equipment (i.e. muck bucket/wheel barrow/pitchfork, bedding). Clean stall required before leaving!!
- Tack (i.e. saddle, bridle, girth, and saddle pads, etc.)
- Grooming supplies and fly spray
- Saddle and bridle racks (if you have them)
- Anything you generally use with your horse at a show or away from home
