NO TEAMS WILL BE FORMED ON SITE! Only preregistered teams will compete for 1st – 6th place ribbons. All others will participate for proficiency certificates and participation ribbons. (Proficiency is scoring 40 – 50 at an individual station).

Teams are one of the following: 2 Srs & 2 Jrs -- or -- 1 Sr & 3 Jrs – or -- 2 Srs & 3 Jrs

All teams will receive a certificate of participation with their scores by station.

Team members will work together to answer as many questions at as many stations as possible.

There will be no time limit for each station, but no answer sheets will be accepted after 12:00.

The idea is to get 4-H’ers working together, learning together and learning from each other.

Cloverbuds are free to go through the stations with a volunteer (adult or senior 4-Her.)

One team allowed at a station at a time. Teams get priority over individuals for station time.

There will be 49 stations covering a variety of horse related topics. Each station will have:

5 “true or false” questions, 10 multiple choice questions, 20 matching, and 5 fill in the blanks or tasks to perform.
