Objectives:

The primary objective of Horse Bowl Competition is to provide an opportunity for youth enrolled in 4-H horse projects, to demonstrate their knowledge of equine-related matters in a competitive setting, where attitudes of friendliness and fairness prevail.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Each **Northern District** unit may enter any number of 4 or 5 member teams. One team member will be designated as the alternate if five contestants are entered. Teams with fewer than four members will not be allowed to play. Counties may combine to form teams, but will need to do so prior to entry. **NO OUT OF DISTRICT MEMBERS WILL BE ALLOWED TO PLAY ON ANY TEAM.**

2. Junior teams will consist of members ages 9-13 as of January 1, 2020. Senior teams will consist of members ages 14-19 as of January 1, 2020. Mixed age teams will not be allowed.

3. Rules will follow as closely as possible those of the Eastern National 4-H Horse Roundup Horse Bowl Competition. Rules can be accessed at the following link: <http://4hroundup.com/rules-horsebowl.htm>

5. Awards: Team ribbons to fifth place, top ten senior individuals and top ten junior individuals. The top **FIVE** teams in each age group will be eligible for EquiSmartz.

6. **Registration procedure:** Mail or e-mail the attached form to: berthadurbin@earthlink.net **Registration is due no later than Feb. 19, 2020.**

7. **Costs: Teams - \$10.** Checks for fees should be made out to **Northern District 4-H Horse Council**, and should be paid at check-in.

8. Lunch will not be served during this contest. Coaches may bring snacks for the participants. Those doing the Hippology contest which follows Horse Bowl will need to bring their own lunch.

10. The top 5 teams in each age group will be eligible to enter the ***EquiSmartz*** State 4-H Horse Bowl Contest. **Please be prepared to submit entries for that contest at the conclusion of the district event in order to obtain the appropriate signatures.** If you should have questions about this process, please contact Bertha Durbin berthadurbin@earthlink.net.
