

Virginia State 4-H Championship Horse and Pony Show

September 5-8, 2024 - Lexington, VA

The State 4-H Horse and Pony Championship Show is hosted at the Virginia Horse Center in Lexington, Virginia. 4-Hers work year round in preparation for this show and have the chance to win prizes, scholarships, trophies, ribbons, and premiums. This show is primarily volunteer run and has hundreds of competitors. It spans over 4 days showcasing a variety of disciplines including Dressage, Hunters, Jumpers, Western, Gymkhana, Ranch, Minis, Driving, Gaited, and Saddleseat.

Top winning riders move on to the Regional contest held in Perry, GA. This show prides itself in being one of the largest youth-only shows held on the East Coast. In addition, it offers many extra educational opportunities for all 4-H youth, including those without access to a horse, such as photography, art, hippology, horse bowl, and horse judging.

With your sponsorship, we will be able to keep entry fees affordable to families so that they can experience a show of this magnitude at the Virginia Horse Center, a world-class, 600-acre facility regularly hosting regional, national, and international equestrian events.

The emphasis of Virginia's 4-H Horse Program is to educate youth on topics such as equine selection, health, nutrition, management, riding, recreation, fun, and horsemanship, while teaching life skills such as leadership, speaking, and record keeping. We recognize that horseback riding provides an outdoor sports fitness program for physical, personal, and emotional development, including confidence building. The sport can develop into a life-long hobby, business, or career. Projects are available for youth owning or having access to horses, and also for youth not having access to horses (horseless horse projects).

Reach: The show hosts approximately 275-350 horse and rider pairs with an estimated additional attendance of approximately 600 spectators and guests.

PLEASE NOTE:

No vendor arrivals permitted before Wednesday, at 10:00 A.M. Horses will not start arriving until Wednesday, 5pm. Tear down begins at the end of the Sunday performance. Vendors must arrange for their own tables/rentals/deliveries/pickup, etc.

Contract of Space:

In the event of fire, strikes or other uncontrollable circumstances, the Virginia 4-H Horse Show shall have no liability or obligation to make any refund.

Space Assignment:

Space assignments will be accepted with a signed contract and payment for display area. The Virginia 4-H Horse Show will assign the spaces. In the event that show management must reconfigure certain areas of the floor assignments, the Virginia 4-H Horse Show reserves the right to assign alternate space. NO exhibitor shall transfer, assign, sell or barter assigned space without the express written consent of the Virginia 4-H Horse Show.

Virginia 4-H Horse Show management and Advisory Executive Committee reserve the right to review products sold and refuse vendor space, in the event that there is a conflict of goods offered with another vendor. The Virginia 4-H Horse Show tries to limit duplication of goods and services offered to ensure each vendor a financially successful show.

Liability:

The exhibitor agrees to assume all risks of loss injury, theft, or damage of any kind or nature whatsoever to any exhibit or component thereof, including goods, merchandise, chattels, papers and business records or other property which may be in or come into the exhibitor's possession during the course of the exhibit and to assume all liability for damage to property, person or persons arising from accidental or other causes incidental to movement and operation of the exhibit area and hereby releases the Virginia 4-H Horse Show and its contractors and the Virginia Horse Center from any liability whatsoever.
