Outside Qualifying Show Exception Rule Details

- Eligibility:
 - Any qualified 4-H member with declared project animal
 - Class shown must be at the equivalent or higher level division that they plan on competing in at the state show.
- Exhibitor Responsibilities:
 - Submit Qualifying request to District Horse Council prior to show.
 - Receive approval from District Horse Council.
 - Submit completed Qualifying form and fee to Horse Council
 - Upload Qualifying Form to FairEntry when registering for State 4H Horse Show
- District Horse Council Responsibilities:
 - Establish a Qualifying fee and deadlines for exhibitors
 - Designate a contact for approvals and approve show requests
 - Submit list of qualified riders/shows to the state office
