## 2020 State 4-H Horse Show Qualifying Rules

<u>For 2020 ONLY</u>, due to COVID-19 restrictions, the following will replace the Horsemanship Skills and Qualifying Shows/Clinics qualifying requirements. **Deadline for submission is September 14, 2020** 

- ANY Horse/Rider combinations that HAS NOT previously ridden together at any State 4-H Show must submit a video demonstrating prescribed skills to the Horsemanship Skills Committee. This applies to Juniors and Seniors and their abilities.
- ANY Horse/Rider combinations (junior or senior) that HAS attended the State Show in the past together DO NOT have to qualify for 2020 with regard to Horsemanship Skills and Qualifying Shows/Clinics.
- January 1 Enrollment, Declaration Deadline and Record Book requirements will remain in place.

## **VIDEO SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:**

This video submission is only valid for the 2020 State 4-H Horse Show and does not mean a Horse/Rider pair has passed Horsemanship Skills for future shows. Horse/Rider combinations will still be required to take and pass Horsemanship Skills for future shows.

To submit a video, please follow these requirements:

- 1. The video must be continuous, no editing, no breaks. If the evaluator suspects your video has been edited, you will be asked to submit the video again.
- 2. At the beginning of the video, please introduce yourself and state the following:
  - a. Name
  - b. Unit Enrolled in
  - c. Club
  - d. Horse Name (show and barn or nick name)
- 3. Demonstrate the following skills:
  - a. Mount
  - b. Walk (both directions
  - c. Trot (both directions)
  - d. Canter (both directions)
  - e. Halt from Trot
  - f. Halter from Canter
  - g. Figure 8 at the Trot
  - h. Figure 8 at the canter with a simple lead change both directions
  - i. Dismount
