# Virginia State 4-H Championship **Horse and Pony Show**

September 8-11, 2022 - Lexington, VA

he State 4-H Horse and Pony Championship Show is hosted at the Virginia Horse Center in Lexington, Virginia. 4-Hers work year round in preparation for this show and have the chance to win prizes, scholarships, trophies, ribbons, and premiums. This show is primarily volunteer run and has hundreds of competitors. It spans over 4 days showcasing a variety of disciplines including Dressage, Hunters, Jumpers, Western, Gymkhana, Ranch, Minis, Driving, Gaited, and Saddleseat.

Top winning riders move on to the Regional contest held in Perry, GA. This show prides itself in being one of the largest youthonly shows held on the East Coast. In addition, it offers many extra educational opportunities for all 4-H youth, including those without access to a horse, such as photography, art, hippology, horse bowl, and horse judging.

With your support we will be able to keep entry fees affordable to families so that they can experience a show of this magnitude at the Virginia Horse Center, a world-class, 600-acre facility regularly hosting regional, national, and international equestrian events.

The emphasis of Virginia's 4-H Horse Program is to educate youth on topics such as equine selection, health, nutrition, management, riding, recreation, fun, and horsemanship, while teaching life skills such as leadership, speaking, and record keeping. We recognize that horseback riding provides an outdoor sports fitness program for physical, personal, and emotional development, including confidence building. The sport can develop into a life-long hobby, business, or career. Projects are available for youth owning or having access to horses, and also for youth not having access to horses (horseless horse projects).

**REACH:** The show hosts approximately 275-400 horse and rider pairs with an estimated additional attendance of approximately 600 spectators and quests.

**Space Assignment:** The Virginia 4-H Horse Show will assign spaces upon receipt of a signed contract and payment. In the event that certain areas must be reconfigured, Show Management reserves the right to assign alternate spaces. No vendor shall transfer, assign, sell, or barter assigned space without the express written consent of the Virginia 4-H Horse Show. Show Management and the Advisory Executive Committee also reserve the right to review products sold and deny vendor space in the event that there is a conflict with goods and services offered by another vendor in order to minimize or prevent duplication and ensure each vendor a financially successful show.

### Trade Show Vendor Contract (continued)

**Liability:** The Virginia 4-H Horse Show and its employees, representatives, designees, and agents thereof shall not be liable for any accident, theft, loss, or damage that may result from Vendor's participation and Vendor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Show and its employees, representatives, and agents for all liability, loss, or damages that may occur including actions engage in by Vendor's employees, independent contractors, and agents. Vendor shall assume all risks of loss injury, theft, or damage of any kind or nature whatsoever to any exhibit or component thereof, including goods, merchandise, chattels, papers and business records or other property which may be in or come into the exhibitor's possession during the course of the exhibit and to assume all liability for damage to property, person or persons arising from accidental or other causes incidental to movement and operation of the exhibit area and hereby releases the Virginia 4-H Horse Show and its contractors and the Virginia Horse Center from any liability whatsoever.

**Insurance:** Vendors shall carry general liability and other insurance coverage that will cover Vendor for all periods of time applicable to this Agreement in the minimum amounts as follows: \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. Vendor shall provide Show Management with Certificate of Liability Insurance naming the Virginia 4-H Horse Show and the Virginia Horse Center as additional insureds.

#### — Use of the 4-H Name and Emblem at the State 4-H Horse Show —

**4-H Name and Emblem:** The 4-H Name and Emblem are protected under federal statute Title 18, U.S. Code 707. This statute protects other federal emblems, like the Seal of the President of the United States. Please see the included information to answer specific questions about how to use these items. If you wish to use the 4-H name and/or emblem, you must first obtain permission from the Virginia State 4-H Office. Under no circumstances, will a Vendor be allowed to sell T-shirts or other products that display the 4-H Emblem or resemblance of the 4-H Emblem without the proper approval. Please submit a written request along with an example of the artwork you plan to use and email to Sandy Arnold, Animal Science Extension Associate, at horse4h@vt.edu for submission to and decision on approval by the Virginia State 4-H Office.
