Those coming should book your room now, especially for those competing in Hippology which spans Friday and Saturday. The communications contests will be on Friday with Seniors checking in at 10am, Juniors at 1pm. Special parking arrangements will be emailed directly to communications contestants. Every contestant, one parent and the coach will receive a free pass into the VHF for the day they compete, checking in through Gate 6. Please be sure to read through ALL the contest rules which also includes language on qualifying. Those wanting to participate in Horse Bowl or Communications need to qualify at the District level.
