- Jan. 1 must be registered as a bonafide 4-H member with your County Extension office.
- May 1 Horse project declaration forms are
- Start your 4-H Horse Record Book now with qoals!
- Plan to qualify at a District Show or Clinic in the spring / summer
- Participate in a county, area, or state 4-H event other than the 4-H district horse show.
- Plan to complete Horsemanship Skills requirements as appropriate.
- Other requirements may be established at the Unit level. Please check with your Extension Agent.
