Jan. 1 Deadline

January 1st is the absolute deadline for those that want to show at the State Fair 4-H Horse Show or the State Championship 4-H Show. Those turning age 9 as of Sept. 30, 2020 are eligible to show. Other show requirements are:

- Declare equine animal project by May 1, 2020 - Qualify at a 2020 4-H Qualifying Show or Clinic
- Pass Horsemanship Skills (read FAQs)
- Submit an up to date 4-H Horse Record Book
- Participate in one County, area, or State 4-H event other than the Qualifying Show or Clinic
- Adhere to other County and/or District level requirements (contact your Extension agent)
