4-H Horse Program Annual Calendar:

October – March: Educational Horse Program Contests and Clinics

- Hippology, Horse Bowl, and Horse Judging Contests and Clinics are hosted throughout the state by Clubs and Districts, and are used as Qualifying events for EquiSmartz in the spring.
- Block and Bridle hippology and horse judging contest usually held early February
- Intro to EquiSmartz – for entry level contestants new to Hippology, Horse Bowl and Horse Judging
- [Communications contests](#) (public speaking, individual and team presentations) hosted by and held in various locations per District as Qualifiers for EquiSmartz.

January 1: All 4-Her's must be enrolled in a club and horse project to be eligible for the State 4-H Horse Show in September and State Fair 4-H Show in October

January: 4-H Equine Advisory Council and State Show Steering Committee

- agents and volunteer leaders from each district plus several at large members meet to review the year, plan the coming year, and establish rules

March /April: EquiSmartz contests

- State contests for Hippology, Horse Bowl, Horse Judging, Public Speaking, Individual and Team Presentations
- Top placing contestants qualify for Southern Regionals, Eastern Nationals and State Horse Judging Team
- Usually held late March or early April (location may vary)

March – July: District Qualifying Shows, Clinics and Horsemanship Skills evaluations for State Show Eligibility

- Youth must qualify at a District show or clinic AND each horse/rider combination who is entering the State Show for the first time must pass Levels 1 and 2 of Horsemanship skills.

May 1: 4-H Project Animal Eligibility/Declaration Hard Deadline

- Eligibility/Declaration hard copy document must be turned in to 4-H agent and information entered into online system to be eligible for the State 4-H Horse Show in September.

June: Mary Cole 50 Mile Horsemaster Trail Ride

- 10 4-Hers accepted
- Late June

July: Hokie Horse Camp

- Held at Virginia Tech
- For ages 16 campers, ages 14-18, overnight camp, bring their own horse
- Costs approximately \$625

July: State Show Entry Deadline

- ~July 12
- Agents must approve and sign all entries for their county and mail by deadline as per the state show rulebook

July/August: Southern Regional 4-H Horse Championships

- Must qualify for this contest from the previous year's State Show
- Held late July, early August in Perry, GA

September: State 4-H Championship Horse and Pony Show

- Youth must be 9 years old or greater to show at the State Show and meet all other show requirements
- Art Contest, Photography contests, Project Book and Portfolio contest, Stall Decorations contest, Stable Management competition.
- Cloverbud Camp on Friday and Saturday
- 600 youth limit, additional 200 in educational competitions
- Virginia Horse Center, Lexington, VA

October: State Fair 4-H Horse Show

- Drill Team competition, Ranch Horse show and 4-H fun show
- The Meadow Event Park, Doswell, Virginia

November: Eastern Nationals 4-H Competitions

- Horse Bowl, Hippology, Horse Judging, Public Speaking, Individual and Team Presentations
- Louisville, KY

November: Block and Bridle Horse Judging Clinic

- Virginia Tech, Blacksburg, VA
