When: **Saturday, July 28, 2018.** Registration begins @ 8AM. Safety review @ 9AM.
(please arrive no later than 10 AM to allow sufficient time to shoot)

Cost: \$25 per Youth \$30 per Adult \$5 for one practice round of 25 skeet .

Who: This Tournament is open to all **Virginia 4-H Shooting Sports Clubs**.
Coaches, parents, former 4-H members and other adults may also participate in the shoot.
The contest will be conducted by certified 4-H volunteer shotgun instructors.

Format: Scoring will be by individual and by team. Awards will be given for
Juniors (4-H ages 9-13), Seniors (4-H ages 14-19), Adult (ages 20+)
The top three scores from each division will be counted for team score.
All shooters are eligible for individual awards.

Rules: All contestants will shoot:
75 targets consisting of 25 skeet, 25 trap and 25 wobble trap.
Bring 100 rounds of shotgun shells.
Four Rivers reserves the right to alter the course due to machinery malfunction or as needed.

Shotguns must be 12 gauge or smaller.
Ammunition shot size should be no larger than 1 1/8 oz. of #7 1/2 .
Eye and ear protection are required for competition.

NO open-toed shoes or tank-tops allowed on the ranges

Coach's Challenge: 25 five-stand targets. \$20. Adults only.
50/50 split pot.
