

2017 State Fair of Virginia Beef Carcass Show

The 2017 State Fair of Virginia Beef Carcass Show was scored and premiums assigned in a similar manner to 2015 and 2016. Carcasses were ranked using the Beef Empire Days carcass index system with additional negative adjustments to carcasses possessing more than 0.80 in of 12th rib fat. This carcass index system adjusts a base carcass index of 100 based on hot carcass weight, 12th rib fat thickness, ribeye area, KPH, and USDA quality grade. This carcass index system rewards carcass that possess a balance of desirable carcass characteristics and removes some of the subjectivity involved with determining a carcass rank. Greater negative adjustments for carcasses having more than 0.80 in of 12th rib fat were made to account for the large variation observed in 12th fat thickness and to adequately penalize these carcasses for their unacceptability to the packing industry. The additional adjustment factors are as follows:

12 th Rib Fat Thickness	Points
0.80 – 0.89	-55
0.90 – 0.99	-60
1.00 – 1.09	-65
> 1.09	-70

Once carcass rank was determined, carcasses were broken into premium groups based on natural breaks in the calculated carcass index. Size and number of carcass premium groups vary from year-to-year to reflect differences in carcass entries. Additional carcass premiums are supported by the Virginia Cattle Feeders Association for carcasses that reflect current industry standards. These carcass specifications and premium levels are listed in the State Fair of Virginia Junior Beef Cattle Show rules (https://ext.vt.edu/content/dam/ext_vt_edu/topics/4h-youth/youth-livestock/shows/state-fair/2017/17-sfva-beef-rules.pdf).

Overall Market Beef Ranking was determined by combining carcass rank and live animal placing by normalizing both live and carcass placings to 100 points and then calculating a weighted average of the 2 scores. Carcass placing accounted for 60% of the weighted average and live placing accounted for 40% of the weighted average. Carcass placing is given greater weight and is more objective than the live placing. The top 5 Overall Market Beef Animals were awarded premiums as described in the State Fair of Virginia Junior Beef Cattle Show rules.
