- Contestants desiring to participate, but not exhibiting sheep at the State Fair, may borrow an animal from another youth exhibitor. Non-exhibitor contestants must be enrolled 4-H/FFA members eligible to show at the State Fair.
- 5. A winning garment from a previous year cannot be entered again in the same age class.
- 6. Judges will determine scores based on the following:
 - a. Garment construction, style, fashion, and accessories
 - b. Contestant's poise and appearancec. Control and presentation of animal
