

SHEEP LEAD LINE CONTEST

1. This contest gives exhibitors an opportunity to showcase a wool outfit and present themselves and a sheep in the most attractive manner.
2. Entrants must select a garment made of at least 70% wool.
3. Garments may be purchased or constructed by the exhibitor.
4. Contestants desiring to participate, but not exhibiting sheep at the State Fair, may borrow an animal from another youth exhibitor. Non-exhibitor contestants must be enrolled 4-H/FFA members eligible to show at the State Fair.
5. A winning garment from a previous year cannot be entered again in the same age class.
6. Judges will determine scores based on the following:
 - a. Garment construction, style, fashion, and accessories 40%
 - b. Contestant's poise and appearance 40%
 - c. Control and presentation of animal 20%
7. Classes will be determined by contestant age as of September 30 of the calendar/show year.
 - a. Junior Division – 9-13
 - b. Senior Division – 14-19
8. Contestants must complete an official leadline entry form and narrative in addition to completing the online entry through the FairEntry system at <https://faireentry.com/Fair/SignIn/14595>. Entry fee is \$5.00/entry.
