
Wisconsin Baitfish and Sportfish

Wisconsin producers spend an estimated \$2.6 million per year on regulatory compliance.

This breaks down to an average cost of \$379,629/farm, or \$14,105/acre.

On average Wisconsin producers are faced with 17 permit and license renewals per year. Some report in excess of 35 annual renewals.
